

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Michael Paul Edward Toland

165 Almond Street Ashland, Oregon 97520

LOCATION:

Situated in a portion of Donation Land Claim No. 40 in the Northeast quarter of Section 8 in Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette

Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To partition that tract of land as originally surveyed and shown on Recorded Survey No. 4870. Prepare legal descriptions for both the parcels which were created by this survey.

PROCEDURE:

The Northerly corner of Parcel No. 2, as monumented on Recorded Survey No. 4870, was not recovered at this time. Evidence of a great deal of digging activity was apparent at the time we searched for this monument. The corner location falls a half foot or so on the Northerly side of an existing power pole. The pole appears to be fairly new; therefore, this may have been the fate of this corner monument. The other monuments either set or found and shown on Recorded Survey No. 4870 were found at this time. The centerline monument found at Almond and Bush Streets and utilized by this survey differs slightly with the monument found and utilized on Recorded Survey No. 4870. In my analyzation of the monuments found and shown on Recorded Survey No. 7629, it was my conclusion that the 1/2 inch iron pipe was more in harmony with both Bush and Almond Streets than was the found 1 inch iron rod. It is interesting that the City of Ashland intersection tie book shows "two (2) pipes with a question mark in parenthesis". The primary notation calls for a pipe. I first visited this intersection location in October, 1971 and found a 1/2 inch pipe and a 1 inch iron rod. Origin of the iron rod is unknown. The 1/2 inch pipe is presumably the result of the City of Ashland Engineering Department in the era of F. Walker, City Engineer. The remainder of the monuments found were determined to be within a 0.1 of a foot or less in relation to the calculated locations; therefore, the monuments found were considered as good.

It should be noted that the descriptions as set forth in Document No. 84-19539 shows the following: Parcel No. 1 utilizes the courses and distances as returned on Recorded Survey No. 4870. Parcel No. 2 utilizes a combination of previously recorded deed bearings and distances with the bearings and distances as shown on Recorded Survey No. 4870. This problem was traced back to Document No. 74-12183 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon. It is believed, by this surveyor, that the scrivener of the last mentioned document failed to adhere to the survey which partitioned this tract of land. The monuments on the ground are what the people in the area are adhering to in good faith. Therefore, I have utilized the intent of the boundary lines of Recorded Survey No. 4870 to control the present descriptions of record.

Page 2 Michael Paul Edward Toland

On Recorded Survey No. 4054 a private road is shown crossing land that is now shown as Parcel No. 2 on the accompanying map. There is a portion of Parcel No. 2 which falls Southwesterly of an existing fence which is along the Easterly side of a dirt surface access way. No attempt was made by this surveyor to verify the validity of this private road.

The remainder of the survey is as shown on the accompanying map.

BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 8 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
