

At Station 131+78.55, set approximately 2 ins. deep an iron pin. 5/8 inches in diameter, 24 ins. long with plastic cap mkd. Jackson C.S. from which;

- 1) Original reference being chisel X top of last concrete post hand rail at the northwest corner of Bear Creek bridge, brs. N47°59'36"E, 81.00 ft.
- 2) Same as above at southwest corner of Bear Creek bridge, brs. N72°38'04"E, 71.82 ft.
- 3) Original nail shinner top of fence post brs. S43°01'20"W, 36.26 ft.

Found traverse point, being a rail spike on Survey No. 9966, approximately 2 ins. deep, brs. N32°40'59"E, 54.29 ft.

Corner monument on Survey No. 5043 (computes from previous co-ordinates) brs. N8°02'40"W, 50.89 ft.

LOCATION:

Northeast quarter of Section 9, Township 38 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

BASIS OF BEARING:

Survey No. 9966. Recovery of traverse stations near the northwest corner of DLC 44 also along the northerly shoulder of Fern Valley Road.

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Purpose of the survey was to locate Bear Creek Valley Sanitation Authority easement over a portion of Jackson County Land.

The original description was described from a survey made in 1967 and 1968. I personally preformed this survey and retain a copy of the field notes. I also prepared the original descriptions which was used to acquire the easements. All original angle points and some of the points on tangent were

At P.I. station 107+18.45, set flush an iron pin, 5/8 inch in diam., 24 inches long with plastic cap marked "Jackson C.S.", from one of the remaining

1) A 5/8 inch iron pin found at the Northeast corner of Lot 14 of Lakeside Estates Mobile Home Park, bears S24°11'39"E, 249.79 feet.

2) Center of a manhole lid bears S8°57'10"E, 1.84 feet.

3) Original nail and shinner on southerly face of tree, 23 inches in diameter cottonwood, bears S72°30'55"E, 46.97 feet (allowance 0.37' was made for 20 year growth of tree)

At P.O.T. station 111+19.03, set flush, an iron pin, 5/8 inch diameter, 24 inches long, with a plastic cap marked Jackson C.S. from which:

- 1) One remaining reference point. Found the original nail and shinner on the southeast face of a 23 inch Cottonwood tree which bears N35°16'40E, 40.88 feet. (Note; allowance 0.21' was made for 20 years of growth on
- 2) Found 5/8 inch iron pin at southeast corner of Lot 14, Lakeside Estates Mobile Home Park, which bears S62°48'W, 15.10 feet.

Station 114+31.53 and 117+45.02 was computed at a projection from 111+19.03 station (from an approximate prorated distance to Station 131+76.55)

Station 122+69.29 and 126+54.54 are at a prorated position.

Station 131+03.50 is a point on tangent between angle points. This point was

1) The center of a manhole lid brs. approximately 0.26 north and

2) An iron pin 5/8 ins. diam. at Station 131+78.55 brs. S13°59'00"E, 75.05 ft. Record filed notes \$14°00'40"E, 75.05 ft.
