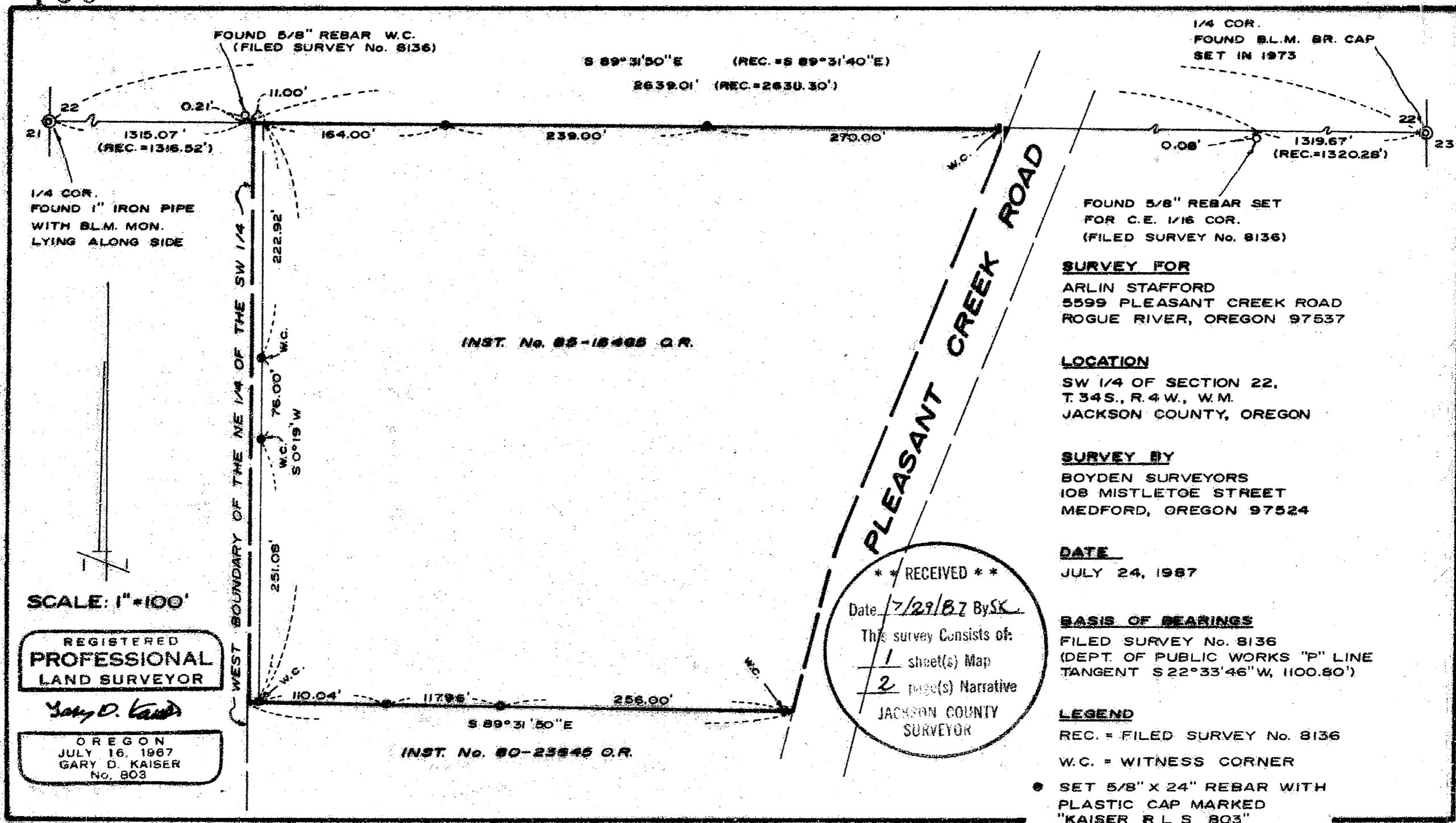

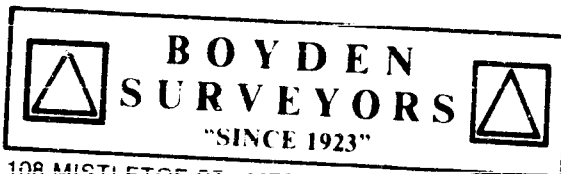

BASIS OF BEARINGS: Filed Survey No 8136 (Dept. of Public Works
"p" line tangent South 22° 33' 46" West,
1100.80 feet). 6 solar observations were
taken, the mean of which checked the basis
of bearings within 0° 01' 30".

DATE: July 24, 1987

PURPOSE: To monument the Northerly and the Southerly
boundaries of that tract described in Inst.
No. 85-18465 O.R. Also to set witness corners
referencing the approximate westerly boundary
of said tract.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. equipment, traversed between the East and
West 1/4 corners to Section 22. The 5/8" rebar set for the center
East 1/16 corner and the 5/8" rebar set as a witness corner to
the center West 1/16 corner on Filed Survey No. 8136 were tied,
the center 1/4 corner was searched for and not found. Also tra-
versed around the subject property.

The Northerly, Southerly and approximate Westerly boundaries
of the subject tract were computed and monumented as shown on
the annexed map.

A fence belonging to the property owner to the South and
adjacent to the subject property encroaches the South boundary
