

Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29 and West $\frac{1}{2}$ of Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, Township 34 South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Cregon.

Basis of Bearing:

Purpose:

To survey property described in Deed Records 81-03834 and to compute acreage of said property.

Procedure:

In 1981 Section 29 was surveyed and recorded on Survey No. 8904. In 1983 Section 28 was surveyed and recorded on Survey No. 9564. I used these surveys to further calculate the subdivision of said sections. I used the control network established on these surveys to run a closed traverse survey around said property.

The Westerly boundry of said property is Cobbleigh Road. I used Jacksom County Road records to determine the location of Cobbleigh Road. The original road location was referenced to the \$\frac{1}{4}\$ corner common to section 28 and 29 from P.I. 124+41.3. In 1951 a portion of Cobbleigh Road was relocated to build a new bridge across Big Butte Creek. The relocation was referenced to the \$\frac{1}{4}\$ corner common to section 28 and 29 from P.T. 40+82.30. I held these positions as referenced to said \$\frac{1}{4}\$ corner. I calculated a new bearing from P.T. 40+82.30 on relocation to F.I. 119+90.7 on original location, and calculated new curve data for F.I. 119+90.7, as shown on plat.

The Southerly boundry of said property is the Northerly Line of roadway described in Volume 396 Fage 370 of Jackson County Deed Records. I traversed along this road as it is constructed and held the constructed Position as best evidence.

References Set This Survey

Centerwest one-sixteenth corner Section 28 T. 34 S. R. 2 E. At the corner location I set a 5/8 by 30 inch rebar with a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch dia. Alum. Cap marked:

T34S R2E S28 CW + 1/16 LS 1086

From which:

A 10½ inch dia. Oak bears S2°03'W 19.7 feet marked CW1/16S28 in upper face. BT in lower face with a 3/4 inch dia. Brass washer marked LS 1086 nailed to face.
A 14 inch dia. Fir bears N 30°41'W 9.5 feet marked CW1/16S28 in upper face. BT in lower face with a 3/4 inch dia. Brass washer marked LS 1686 nailed to face.
