SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Situated in the Southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County,

Oregon.

PURPOSE:

A public sanitary sewer line was installed to serve houses in the general vicinity. Before construction, a witness corner was set to hold the North line of Parcel No. 2 of that Major Land Partition filed in Volume 2, page 81 of Major Land Partitions in Jackson County, Oregon as the sanitary sewer line runs through the Northeast

corner of said parcel.

PROCEDURE:

Found the 3/4 inch galvanized iron pipes as shown. Set over the Northeast pipe monument and sighted the Northwest pipe monument. Set a 5/8 x 24 inch iron rod with cap and brass nail for Witness Corner.

BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 8 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the

office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
