PURPOSE:

To retrace the Southerly and Easterly boundaries of the tract conveyed from J. Morris Tucker to Harriet M. Winton by Volume

549, Page 344, Deed Records.

PROCEDURE:

Mr. Holt informed the writer that he has testimony from Mr. Tucker and Mrs. Winton stating the Southerly boundary of the tract conveyed from Tucker to Winton is North from the line surveyed off the well casing on Filed Survey No. 8981. Mr. Holt also informed the writer that the testimony states the tract conveyed contains 5 acres and the South boundary was

marked with stakes. The date the 3/4" iron pipe monuments noted as found on Filed Survey No. 8981 were set was not

determined but their location was reported to the writer by

Mr. Holt as being, if not the actual "stakes" mentioned by

Mr. Tucker and Mrs. Winton, they could be marking the same

line. Area computations of the tract tend to verify this,

4.95 acres computed compared to the 5 acres reported to Mr. Holt by Mr. Tucker and Mrs. Winton. The Easterly 3/4" iron

pipe was found lying on the ground and was remonumented with

a 5/8" x 24" rebar at the position indicated on Filed Survey

No. 8981 as is shown on the annexed map. No other well cas-

ing was found but it is possible one could have existed and

was washed away as there is evidence of the river bank eroding

Easterly.
