History of original corner establishment:

The original one-quarter corner Section 2, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, and Section 35, Township 39 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, was established by Samuel W. Lackland Under Contract No. 429, dated 1/05/1882. This corner was changed to one of minimum control for Section 2 only during a resurvey by Rufus S. Moore under Contract No. 504, dated 5/27/1884

Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner point, I found a $10" \times 10" \times 12"$ quartz stone, with 1/4 marked on north face, firmly set 6 inches in the ground, and the following accessories:

A pine stump bears N.65°02'W., 21.3 feet distance, with scribe 1/4S visible on a burnt face, and dead and down pine alongside.

A root hole bears \$.32°25'E., 24.5 feet distance, with loose pine face scribed 1/4S alongside.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point, I replaced stone with a 2-1/2-inch diameter by 30-inch long iron post 26 inches in the ground, with a 2-1/2-inch brass cap marked as shown in diagram, and mark the following accessories:

A 10-inch diameter fir bears N.51°17'E., 7.3 feet distance, scribed X BT.

A 14-inch fir bears $5.24^{\circ}39^{\circ}E.$, 35.3 feet distance, scribed 1/4S2 LS1071 BT
