Procedure:

Tax Lot 1200, the west half of a tract described in Volume 492, page 48, Official Records Jackson County Oregon required the determination of the following street right of ways:

- North right of way of Bristol Street
- 2) North right of way of Peachey Road
- 3) West right of way of Hillview Drive

Bristol Street was defined by locating monuments set during the Kensington Subdivision (Ager October 18, 1965); a 3/4 inch iron pipe found by Ager and situated along the northerly right of way of Bristol Street, fit well with the existing fences and helped define the southerly boundary of Tax Lot 1200. It should be noted here the Initial Point of the Kensington Subdivision was searched for during this survey, but evidently has been destroyed during various improvements to Hillview Drive.
