

Survey Narrative To Comply With O.R.S. 209 250

Survey For:

Jerry Michael 13575 Highway 234 Gold Hill, OR 97525

Location:

A portion of the E. 1/2 of Sec. 18, T.37 S., k.3 W., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To monument and mark the North line and part of the West line of the client's property and to monument the S,E, corner of said property.

Procedure:

Using existing control established by this office during Survey No. 9513. I set corners and flagged and blazed the property lines as shown on the accompanying map.

At the Center-North 1/16 corner I set a 5/8 x 30" rebar with plastic cap stamped FRIAR PLS 961 from which:

A 1" iron pipe bears N 82 E, 15.6 feet. A 12" maple bears S 05 W., 10.2 feet; scribed CN1/16S18BT.

At the North 1/16 corner common to Secs. 17 & 18, I set a 5/8" x 24" rebar with plastic cap stamped FRIAR PLS 961 from which:

A 6" madrone bears N 52 E, 2.1 feet; scribed N1/16S17BT.

A 24" madrone bears S 56 W, 2.6 feet; scribed N1/16S18BT.

At the South 1/16 corner common to Secs. 17 & 18, I set a 5/8" x 30" rebar with plastic cap stamped FRIAR PLS 961 from which:

An 18" fir bears N 88 E, 10.0 feet; scribed \$1/16S17BT.

A 6° fir bears N 37 W, 8.1 feet; scribed S1/16S18BT.
