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but also that same was considered within the limits of positional tolerance. This matter was further discussed with the surveyor signing Filed Survey No. 8202 to determine if additional pertinent data might favor the position as calculated (but not monumented) on Filed Survey No. 8202. From this control, the position for the NW 1/16 corner was computed and monumented with a 3/4" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 36" in the ground with a 2 1/2" br. cap marked:



A 7" W.O. scribed "NW 1/16 S3-BT" bears North 45° 03' West, 55.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

A 7" W.O. scribed "NW 1/16 S3-BT" bears North 29° 09' East, 58.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

The Easterly right-of-way line of Foothill (County) Road was located per found monuments set on a survey in progress by the Jackson County Department of Public Works. Also see Foothill Road Bargain and Sale Deed, Instrument No 85-08951 O.R., which apparently does not clarify the Westerly right-of-way line of Foothill Road.

The private road and Parcel No. 2 boundaries were located consistent with the approved tentative plat and monumented as shown on the annexed map.
