## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

William Clayton Colley 211 Van Ness Avenue Ashland, Oregon 97520

LOCATION:

Situated in a portion of Lots 2 and 3 of Block 11 to the City of Ashland in Donation Land Claim No. 40 in the Southeast quarter of Section 5, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To partition a tract or parcel of land into two (2) parcels of land as shown on the accompanying map and as approved by the City of Ashland Planning Department.

PROCEDURE:

From control established in the course of Recorded Survey Nos. 4704, 8040, 8610 and 10588, proceeded to establish the boundary lines of Lots 2, 3 and 4 of Block 11 by proportion. This introduced some very interesting circumstances in regards to the lines of occupation. Suffice it to say, the side lines of said parent tract of land was stablized by securing a Boundary Line by Agreement on the Southeasterly side and a Boundary Line by Agreement is presently being considered by the common council of the City of Ashland along the Northwesterly side of said tract of land. The remainder of said survey is as shown on the accompanying map.

BASIS OF BEARING: True Meridian at the East Line of Section 5 as derived from the Mational Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
