Situated in the Southwest Quarter of Section 32,

Township 38 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base

and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To Locate those monuments set on Recorded Survey No. 4084 and establish true intersects with the relocated

right of way line of Pacific Highway. Also, to

establish a proposed division line for a future two lot

Partition. Prepare three legal descriptions.

PROCEDURE:

From previous traverse control, proceeded to expand control in the subject area. Traversed the centerline of the existing railroad tracks and located monuments

on the relocated Pacific Highway. Applying a measurement index factor to the State Highway Departments distances, the index factor having

Departments distances, the index factor having been established prior on the Herb Lewis Survey No 7020, produced a very close fit with those right of way monuments as found and shown on the accompanying map.

BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at West 1/16 section corner of Section 32 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
