

The north line of said Lot 3 is therefore accepted as being parallel to Clark for the purpose of this survey.

Monuments presumable established by Survey No. 62
were tied to. Surveyor Clabby established all
dimension at MINGUS SUBDIVISION plat record and
at 90° to the east line of HIGHTS SUBDIVISION.
This does not conform to the procedure described for
the present survey. Occupancy appears to be close
to the Clabby survey location, however.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument parcels according to legal description furnished by client.

PROCEDURE:

The subject property is described from the Northwest Corner of Lot 3, Block 2, MINGUS SUBDIVISION, circa 1891. The west line of Lots 3 and 4 are coincident with the east line of HIGHTS SUBDIVISION, circa 1925. In 1979 this office retraced the east line of HIGHTS SUBDIVISION as monumented by stone monuments, being recorded survey No. 8074.

The Initial Point of HIGHTS SUBDIVISION is described as being North 0° 22' West, 30.0 feet from the Southeast Corner of MINGUS SUBDIVISION, Lot 5, Block 2, which would also be the Southwest Corner of said Lot 3.

It is also apparent that the most northerly corner of HIGHTS SUBDIVISION is coincident with the most northerly corner of said Lot 5, MINGUS SUBDIVISION.

Based upon this conclusion and the measurements obtained for said Survey No. 8074, the pro-rate location for the Northwest Corner of said Lot 3, MINGUS SUBDIVISION, was computed resulting in dimension of 422.26 feet to the north line of Clark Street as compared to a record distance of 420.78 feet, a difference of 1.48 feet.

A further conclusion to accept the centerline of Clark Street as the south line of said Lot 3, MINGUS SUB-DIVISION, is discussed in considerable detail in the narrative for Survey No. 5370 and said narrative by this reference thereto is made a part of this survey.
