PURPOSE:

To survey and monument parcel according to legal description furnished by client.

PROCEDURE:

The subject parcel was originally surveyed and monumented by Survey No. 1964 as tracts W4 and W5. All original monuments on the subject parcel have apparently been destroyed.

The centerline of Falcon Street (formerly "F" Street) was established from brass cap monuments found. The origin of the two brass cap monuments at 23rd and 24th Streets is unknown at this time.

Although Survey No. 1964 is not a formal Subdivision, some 53 tracts are shown thereon. Therefore, pro-rate dimensions were computed for the subject parcel based on the measurements between brass cap street monuments as compared to record.
