SURVEY NARRATIVE

LOCATION:

In the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 40 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jack-

son County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To monument a proposed Lot Line Adjustment, adding a portion of those Parcels shown on Survey 4269 as #25 and #26 to the unnumbered Parcel adjoining said Parcels 25 & 26 on the Southeast side thereof.

PROCEDURE:

All Parcels involved in this survey were surveyed out in the course of Survey 4269. Monuments per that survey, the only survey in the area, were found in good condition as shown on the accompanying plat.

The client wished to add a portion of Parcels 25 & 26 to the 20 acre triangular Parcel to the Southeast, so as to include a potential house site.

I began my survey at the CE 1/16th corner which is monumented with a 1" galvanized iron pipe per Survey 4269. I then traversed S 45°01'33" W, establishing a basis for bearings, and tied the monuments along that line as shown on the accompanying plat. I then traversed to Tyler Creek Road and tied the Parcel corners along said road, and also the right-of-way curve monuments, all per Survey 4269.

I then set monuments along the Northeast line of Parcel 26 line of Parcel 25 to monument the limand the Southwest its of the proposed Lot Line Adjustment as per instructions from the owner and client, Mr. Thomas Habecker.

Date of Survey: October 25, 1988

Bearings are based on the line running from the C-E 1/16th Corner, S 45°01'33" W, 484.98' to the most Southerly corner of Parcel 26 per Survey 4269.
