PURPOSE:

To survey and monument parcel described in Instrument No. 81-05273 subject to Boundary Line Agreements recorded as Instrument Nos. 81-16197 and 82-14357.

PROCEDURE:

Conducted a traverse from the Northeast corner to the Northwest corner of D. L. C. 48 and monuments along the east boundary of Survey No. 7464. The traverse was then extended easterly along the Medford Corporation Railroad, abandoned by Deed Record Volume 562, page 418 thru 420, to various monuments established by Survey Nos. 9441 and 8971. This traverse revealed that a fence has been constructed along the approximate centerline of the abandoned railroad, establishing a line of occupancy at variance with the various legal descriptions which describe the southerly right of way line.

A Boundary Line Agreement was prepared for this line and recorded as Instrument No. 88-05380. The Lot Line adjustment was approved by Jackson County Planning March 18, 1988.
