

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Valley of the Rogue Bank

110 Pine Street Rogue River, Oregon

LOCATION:

Northwest 1/4 of Section 18, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, WM., Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

Monument the boundaries of Tax Lots 2800 & 3900

PROCEDURE:

This property had been surveyed by this office in 1985, and filed as Survey No. 10373. Since then the City of Medford has acquired a strip for the widening of Poplar Drive. The subsequent construction activity destroyed the monumentation set at that time.

Since the area acquired by the City was described by metes and bounds description, as was the original street right of way, the street centerline monumentation was not used to determine the property boundary.

The 12.50 foot radius curve in the property boundary was positioned to be tangent to the right of way boundary of relocated Hilton Road as determined by Survey 10373.

From the 3/4" iron pipe found on the south boundary of vacated Hilton Road, the bearing of S 70°20'21" W was used as determined by Survey 10373. The ½" iron pin found on the earlier survey at the westerly end of this line is no longer available.
