

Survey Narrative to comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

Survey For:

Location:

Pleasant View Subdivision, to the City of Ashland, NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To equitably divide a portion of Tax Lot 1000 among seven property owners of the Pleasant Valley Subdivision with a boundary line adjustment.

Procedure:

Pleasant Valley Subdivision which was platted by Ager April 4, 1987 (R.S. 2145), provided the original seven lot configuration and dedicated right of way of Norton Street. Tax Lot 1000, owned by client is adjacent and southwesterly of View Pleasant Subdivision; Controlling during R.S. 4332 defined the monuments set adjusted projected southwesterly boundary and also helped determine the southwesterly right of way of Ashland Mine Road. The original Pleasant View Subdivision was tied to a Section Corner common to Sections 31, 32, 5, and 6; Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian a 1 1/2 inch crimped iron pipe also set by Ager. However, this monument was not accepted by local surveyors and eventually reset by Swain during R.S. 4457; his reasons for resetting this monument are well documented in his narrative of said survey. All required monuments not located during the initial control traverse were reset according to record. The new lot configuration fit well with existing improvements, specifically a fence corner located at the southeast portion of Lot 1, Block 1, Pleasant View Subdivision.

Basis of Bearing:

South right of way line of Ashland Mine Road as per Pleasant Valley Subdivision, (Record of Survey No. 4332.)
