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At the South one-sixteenth corner on the West boundary of Section 28, Set A 1"x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a plastic cap marked "Kaiser R L S 803".

From Which:

A 9" White Oak scribed "S 1/16 S 28-BT" bears North 30° 58' E, 7.1 to the face of the lower blaze.

The Easterly fork of a 10" twin White Oak scribed " S 1/16 S 28-BT", bears South 16° 50' East, 8.2' to the face of the lower blaze.
