

DEPENDENT RETRACEMENT SURVEY OF THE M.J. & J.T. RUFFATTO PROPERTY IN GOVT. LOT 4 & SE% OF SECTION 20, T36S, R4W, W.M., JACKSON CO., OR

Narrative description to comply with Par. 209.250, 0.R.S. (Note 1 separate map sheet accompanies this narrative)

Purpose: To find and verify, or reset as needed, corner and witness corner monuments of said property.

Procedure: Survey Nos. (S/N) 1508,3866,4209,8546, and 8630 were researched and studied for useable information. The Easterly line of the Ruffatto property had been established and monumented by S/N 1508, and was later used for reference and bearing basis for properties lying easterly (S/N 8546) and westerly (S/N's 3866 & 4209) of said line. My survey ran a control traverse around the approximate boundaries of said property, finding the NW, NE, and SE witness corner monuments. After computing and checking said monuments for correct position, additional monuments were searched for, and found as shown on my map, being 5/8" rather than the 1/2" I. Rods stated in S/N 3866. None of the above S/N's indicated finding the 2 additional monuments near the SE witness corner. The SW witness corner monument, being badly bent and displaced, was then replaced, and an additional Easterly line witness monument was set just southerly of the as-built Fielder Lane. 4 Foot wood laths were also set to mark the Ruffatto Easterly and Westerly lines. Measurements were made as shown on my map to verify the boundary at the mean high water mark of the Rogue River's right bank.

The bearing basis used was the record S $8^{\circ}30^{\circ}E$ shown and monumented on said Easterly line by S/N's 1508,3866, and 8546.
