## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Copeland Yards Inc., an Oregon Corporation

formerly J.W. COPELAND YARDS, an Oregon Corporation

LOCATION:

Situated in the Northwest Quarter of Section 9,

Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base

and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the boundary lines of that tract of land as set forth in Volume 254, Page 64 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon per the request of the City of Ashland Planning Director.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing previously established survey control, I then established new survey control in the immediate area of the subject survey. It became apparent after much research and many calculations that a Boundary Line by Agreement was in order for the line between Copeland's and Thornton's. After long delays, this has been accomplished and the filing number is as shown on the accompanying map. The existing curbs on Lithia Way, as established by the Oregon State Highway Department, were deemed to be the best and most reliable evidence as to what the State had intended to take from the Property Owners when widening 'C' Street and creating the Lithia Way By-Pass. The remaining information is as shown on the accompanying map.

## BASIS OF BEARING:

True Meridian at the North-South centerline of Section 9 as derived from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (formerly Coast and Geodetic Survey) survey net established in 1968 and filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
