

Survey Narrative to comply with Paragraph 209.250 Oregon Revised Statutes

Survey For:

Catherine M. Shauger 271 Beach Street Ashland, Oregon 97520

Location:

Southwest quarter, Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To partition a tract of land into two parcels as per the Findings and Orders of Planning Action 89-005 Ashland Planning Commission utilizing a six foot southerly set back from a garage/shop building as the boundary between Parcel 1 and Parcel 2 and as per clients request.

Procedure:

Began control survey in vicinity of the quarter corner common to Section 9 and Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, tying street monuments situated at the following intersections:

Ashland Street/Taylor Street Taylor Street/Holly Street Holly Street/Idaho Street Holly Street/Gresham Street

These monuments were used as control during Record of Survey Number 6308 (Swain) providing a relationship between the breakdown of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 9 and the existing street certerline The outer boundary of clients parcel monuments. was monumented according to Document Number 71-16144 Official Record Jackson County, Oregon. Clients tract shares a common boundary with a portion of the easterly boundary of the Vander Lind Homes Subdivision (R.S. 11431). An existing feace at the monthwest Tanana & Document Number 71fence at the northwest corner of Parcel 2 and a small outbuilding at the southwest corner of Parcel 1 were found encroaching onto clients property and noted as such on the accompanying
