PURPOSE: Locate and monument the exterior boundaries of  
the client's ownership as described in Instrument  
No. 85-15056 of the Official Records.

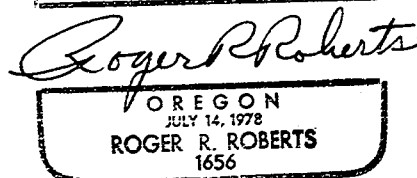
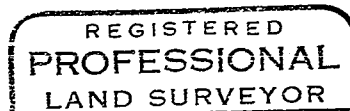
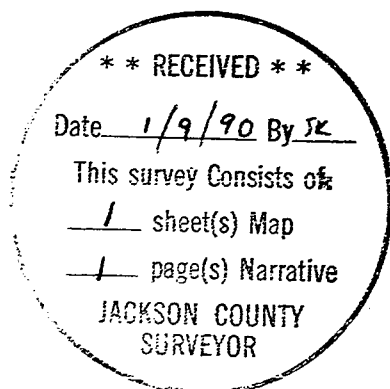
PROCEDURE: The deed description commences at the southwest  
corner of Section 15, and calls easterly along the  
section line to the westerly right of way boundary  
of Crater Lake Highway. The control established  
by this office during Survey No. 6274 was used to  
determine the location of the section line, rather  
than re-running the line.

The monument near the intersection of the  
section line and the westerly right of way  
boundary was found exposed 9 inches high in the  
ditchline, indicating that it may have been  
disturbed since it was originally set. The 3/4"  
pipe shown found on the easterly boundary of the  
highway and the monument found on the north side  
of Maple Street were used to control the westerly  
boundary of the highway.

The parcel was monumented as shown, holding  
record angle in relation to the right of way  
boundary.
