

At the CW 1/16 Corner of Section 6:

A 15" diam. Fir bears N. 83 1/2° E., 16.22 ft A 9" diam. Hemlock brs. N. 60 W., 34.00 ft.

At the 1/4 Corner common to Sections 31 + 6: A 6" diam. Madrone brs. N. 73° E., 11.82 ft. A 15" Madrone brs. S. 56° E., 13.17 ft.

The 5/8" diam. steel pin wit. cor. to the SE cor. of Exception "d" from Parcel 3, Vol. 531, Pg. 204 bears N. 60 32' 26" W., 50.29

The 5/8" diam. steel pin set on the North -South center line of Section 6 bears S. 00 52' 40" E., 794.62 ft.

Bearing trees were scribed "X BT" on double blazes for each of the other monuments set on this survey, measured to center of tree at root crown, and are situated as follows:

At the witness corner in Section 31: An 8" diam. Madrone brs. N. 850 E., 35.80 ft. A 4" diam. Madrone brs. S 350 E., 18.60 ft.

At the witness corner in Section 1: A 7" diam. Pine bears N. 38° E., 23.15 ft. A 6" diam. Cedar bears S. 570 E., 5.90 ft.

At the N'ly witness corner in Section 12: A 6" diam. Fir bears N. 580 E., 33.73 ft. An 8" diam. Fir bears S. 600 E., 29.30 ft.

At the S'ly witness corner in Section 12: An 8" diam. Fir bears N. 70 E., 23.32 ft. A 9" diam. Madrone bears S. 680 E., 29.82 ft. A hiking trail is 3.5 ft. Westerly.

At the most N'ly property corner in Section 6: An 8" diam. Fir bears N. 10° E., 40.25 ft. An 8" diam. Hemlock brs. S. 32 1/20 E., 12.60

At the most W'ly property corner in Section 6: An 8" diam. Fir bears N. 57° E., 30.60 ft. A 9" diam. Fir bears S. 12° E., 21.90 ft.

At the remaining property corner in Section 6: A 5" diam. Hemlock brs. S. 290 E., 3.95 ft. A 10" diam. Fir bears N. 670 W., 4.80 ft.

Monuments set on this survey consist of 5/8" x 30" steel pins with red plastic caps mkd. "D.A. EDWARDS-RPLS 2339".

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH CHAPTER 209, PARAGRAPH 250, **OREGON REVISED STATUTES** 

SURVEY FOR: Boise Cascade Timber and Wood Products Group

LOCATION: In Section 31, T. 32 S., R. 3 E., W.M., Section

6, T. 33 S., R. 3 E., W.M. and Section 12, T. 33 S., R. 2 E., W.M. all in Jackson County,

Oregon.

PURPOSE: To locate and monument the SE corner of Gov't.

Lot 5, the SE 1/16 corner of Section 1 and certain other property corners as shown on the attached plat. Also, to mark property

boundaries by blazing trees and setting metal

tags along those boundaries shown on the

accompanying plat as bold lines.

PROCEDURE: Two closed loop control traverses were

executed, both of which closed about 1:20,000. These were then balanced and adjusted. From points in these control loop, several short side traverses were run to tie in the required controlling Section and 1/4 corners. Existing control points and data from Recorded Survey

Number 11510 were also utilized.

In Section 12, a combination of my ties to the North line of the Section and record angles shown on R.S.N. 9215 was used to compute a position for the North 1/16 corner of 11 + 12 and the direction of the North line of the South 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 12. Deed Record angles and distances, as per Doc. No. 72-10617, were then used to compute the location of the SW'ly line of Tax Lot 200.

In Section 31, existing control points established during R.S.N. 11510 were used to run the East line of Exception "d", Parcel 3, described in Vol. 531 , Page 204, Deed Records. The proportionate 1/4 corner common to Sections 6 and 31 and the witness corner to the SE corner of said tract were, however, monumented from a point established from the control loop. This was done to insure accurate placement of said monuments, as the slope running South from Mill Creek Drive is exceedingly steep.

For those corners described as being "350 feet from the Rogue River", ties were made to the river bank at the necessary points and

monuments set at the locations shown.

At Sectional subdivision corners, bearing trees were scribed according to the 1973 B.L.M. Manual, measured to the center of tree at root crown and are situated as follows:

At the SE 1/16 Corner of Section 1:

A 6" diam. Alder bears S. 22° W., 11.18 ft. A 4" diam. W. Oak brs. N. 53° W., 14.35 ft. A foot trail is 15 ft. North.
