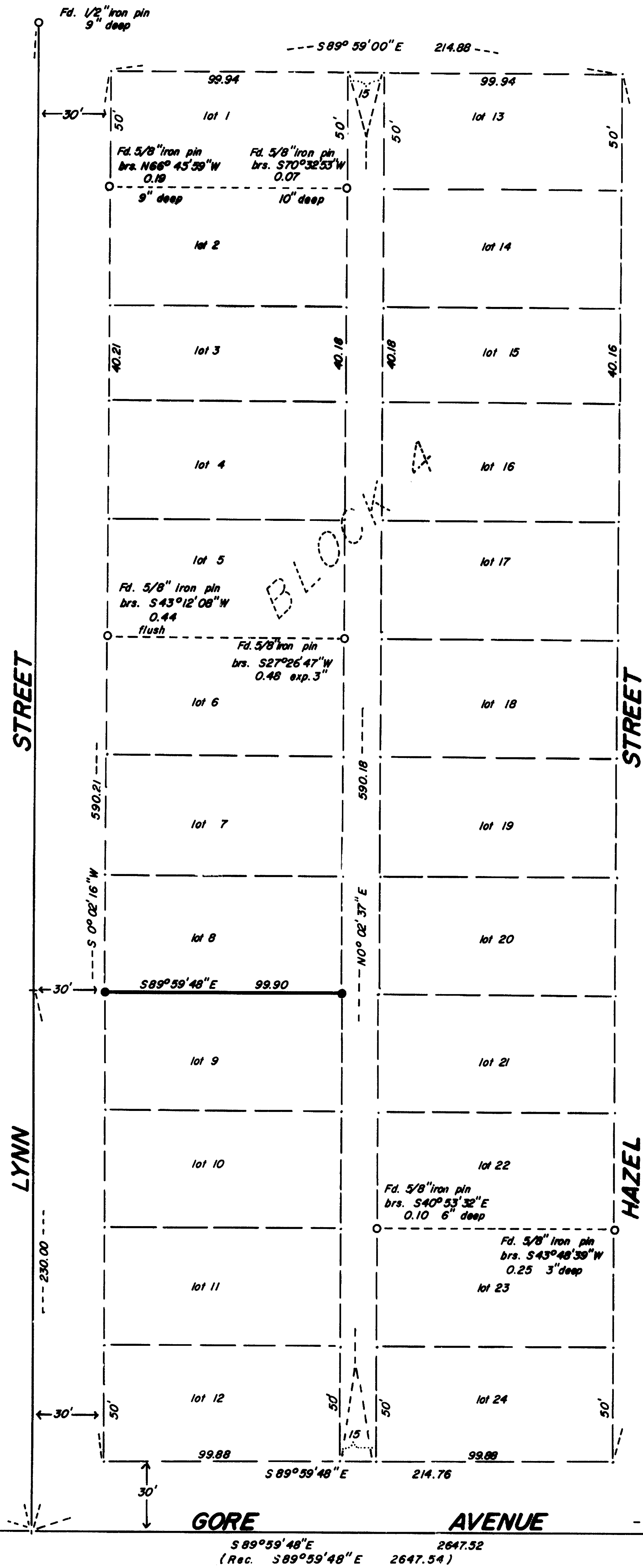


# MAP of SURVEY

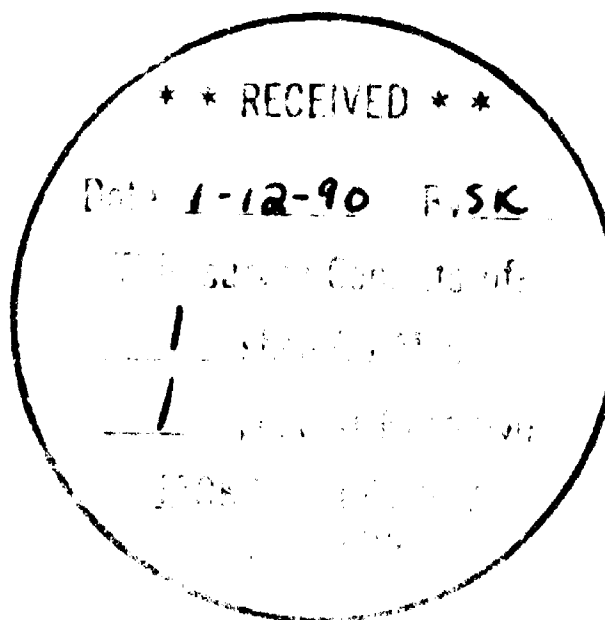

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

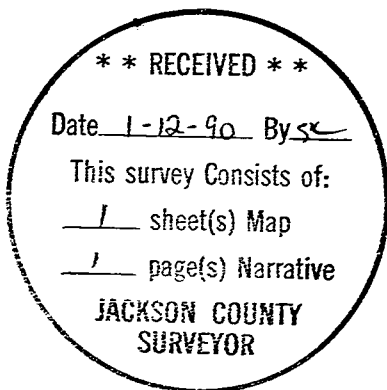

Location: Located in Block 4, Lot 9 of the Berryvale Addition to the City of Medford, Donation Land Claim No. 60, in the southwest quarter of Section 13, Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

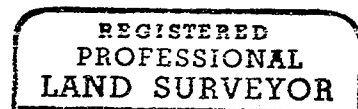
Purpose: To monument the north line of that tract described in Instrument No. 73-18239 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

Procedure: I recovered and tied the monuments set in the performance of Filed Surveys No. 2923 and 5452 which were set in Block 4 as well as the south line of DLC No. 60. The monuments tied do not conform with record information and are not original subdivision monuments. I held the south line of the DLC which is also the center line of Gore Avenue and the monument on northerly center line of Lynn Street and the computed position of Lynn Street on the DLC line. Using this information I computed the location of the lot corners of Block 4 maintaining the record public right of ways. If I had held the positions of the found monuments it would have created many angle points in the right of ways. I therefor established the monuments for the north line of Lot 9 at my computed positions.

Bearing is based on the south line of DLC No. 60 as per Filed Survey No. 5452.
