Survey Narrative To Comply With O.R.S. 209.250

Purpose:

To survey and monument the Southerly right-of-way of a proposed section of the Bear Creek Greenway Bike Path lying outside the Southerly right-of-way of Eagle Mill-Antelope Road to be purchased by Jackson County, and to remonument a portion of the centerline of the Bike Path as shown on Survey No.

Procedure:


Recovered monuments and control established by this office during Survey No. 10704. Tied in proposed centerline points set by Parks and Recreation personnel and calculated the Southerly right-of-way. Given new curve data supplied by the Parks and Recreation Department, reset the pins in the new centerline location. Monuments found, set or removed are as shown on the annexed map.
