Survey Narrative To Comply With O.R.S. 209.250

Location:

A portion of the W. 1/2 of Sec. 5, T.35 S., R.3 W.,

W.H., Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To survey and monument a Nonfarm Dwelling Parcel according to conditions set forth in Jackson County

Planning Dept. File No. 89-47-HP.

Procedure:

Tied in corners set during Survey No. 3451 and 3537 as control. After researching deeds to the subject parcel, I concluded that the intent of the deeds was to hold the position of the monuments set by Survey No. 3451 and 3537 and not the call for the East-West centerline, since the deeds called for these monuments and fences have been built using these monuments. The approximate location of the Southeasterly right-of-way of East Evans Creek Road was determined from the painted center stripe. Calculated positions of the corners of the nonfarm dwelling parcel so as to have a minimum of 1 acre. Those monuments found and those set are as shown on the annexed map.
