

HISTORY OF SURVEYS

THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THIS SECTION WERE ESTABLISHED BY DEPUTY SURVEYORS WILLIAM M. TURNER AND JAMES HOWARD UNDER CONTRACT NO. 142 DATED SEPTEMBER 9, 1870.

THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 28 WAS RETRACED DURING A DEPEND-ENT RESURVEY BY PETER APPLEGATE DURING CONTRACT NO. 651, DATED APRIL 25, 1896.

CONTROLLING CORNERS HAD BEEN REMONUMENTED BY EITHER THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR OR HAROLD L. CENTER, REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR NO. 1071.

NO OTHER SURVEYS OF RECORD WERE NOTED.

SET 2 1/2" X 30" LONG IRON POST WITH 2 1/2" DIAMETER BRASS CAP. CORRECTED LOCATION THIS SURVEY.

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FOUND STANDARD B.L.M. OR COUNTY SURVEYOR BRASS CAP MONUMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.



NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

BASIS OF BEARING:

Solar Observation - Bearings Based On Record Survey No. 9511

PURPOSE:

This survey is to correct record Survey No. 9511 (Jackson County Surveyor File No.). This survey represents a Corrective Section Subdivision to reposition corners monumenting the southwest quarter of Section 28. On or about the 20th of December 1989 I was notified by Aurther R. Rambo, RPLS No. 1086 that he was conducting a survey for Medford Corporation in the south half of Section 28 and he was unable to match my distances between monuments on the east - west centerline of Section 28. It appeared to Rambo that the center one quarter and center east one-sixteenth corner had been established about 3 feet east of the correct position. After review and evaluation of my survey control I was able to determine I had utilized a series of adjusted traverse lines which caused a systematic shift in the

position of the interior section subdivision corners.

PROCEDURE:

I began the corrective survey with recovery of my original control traverse points. I then performed an additional traverse in order to eliminate the need for multiple traverse lines/closures and reduce my traverse control to one primary loop. This provided an excellent closure and the interior corner points I had previously established (Road Survey No. 9511) were adjusted to the locations as shown on the attached record of survey map. I utilized the original accessories, except as noted, with the revised bearing and distances noted within this narrative. Property lines were reposted with metal posts with National Forest Boundary Signs attached. Trees were reblazed and painted with red timber marking paint.

This corrective survey was performed utilizing a wild T-2 Theodolite and Leitz Red 2-L Electronic Distance Meter.

Corners Accepted For Control

Controlling corners required for the subdivision of this section were not visited and will not be redescribed within this narrative. Those corners include:


Northeast Section Corner Southeast Section Corner Southwest Section Corner North, South, East and West One-Quarter Corners

Corner Point Locations Corrected This Survey

Center one-quarter corner Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 2 East.

At the corner point I set a 2 1/2-inch diameter galvanized iron post with a 2 1/2 inch diameter brass cap marked:





A 17-inch diameter fir bears S 89°35'E, 110.83 feet distance. Scribed C1/4 S28 LS1071-BT.

A 9-inch diameter fir bears N $0^{\circ}30$ 'E, 21.12 feet distance. Scribed C1/4 S28 LS1071-BT.

Center-north one-sixteenth corner Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 2 East.

At the corner point I set a 2 1/2 inch diameter galvanized iron post with a 2 1/2-inch diameter brass cap marked:



And the following references:

A 6-inch diameter pine bears N $56^{\circ}38$ 'E, 19.60 feet distance. Scribed CN 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

A 12-inch diameter fir bears S 01°21'W, 90.80 feet distance. Scribed CN 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

Northeast one-sixteenth corner Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 2 East.

At the corner point I set a 2 1/2 inch diameter galvanized iron post with a 2 1/2-inch diameter brass cap marked:

And the following references:

A 10-inch diameter fir bears S $69^{\circ}53$ 'E, 9.60 feet distance. Scribed NE 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

A 14-inch diameter pine bears N $27^{\circ}18$ 'E, 62.20 feet distance. Scribed NE 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

Center-east one-sixteenth corner Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 2 East.

At the corner point I set a 2 1/2-inch diameter galvanized iron post with a 2 1/2-inch diameter brass cap marked:

And the following references:

A 15-inch diameter cedar bears N $09^{\circ}46'\text{E}$, 22.80 feet distance. Scribed CE 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

A 13-inch diameter fir now dead bears N $53^{\circ}29$ 'E, 90.40 feet distance. Scribed CE 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.

A 10-inch diameter pine bears N $75^{\circ}26$ 'E, 69.10 feet distance. Scribed CE 1/16 S28 LS1071 BT.
