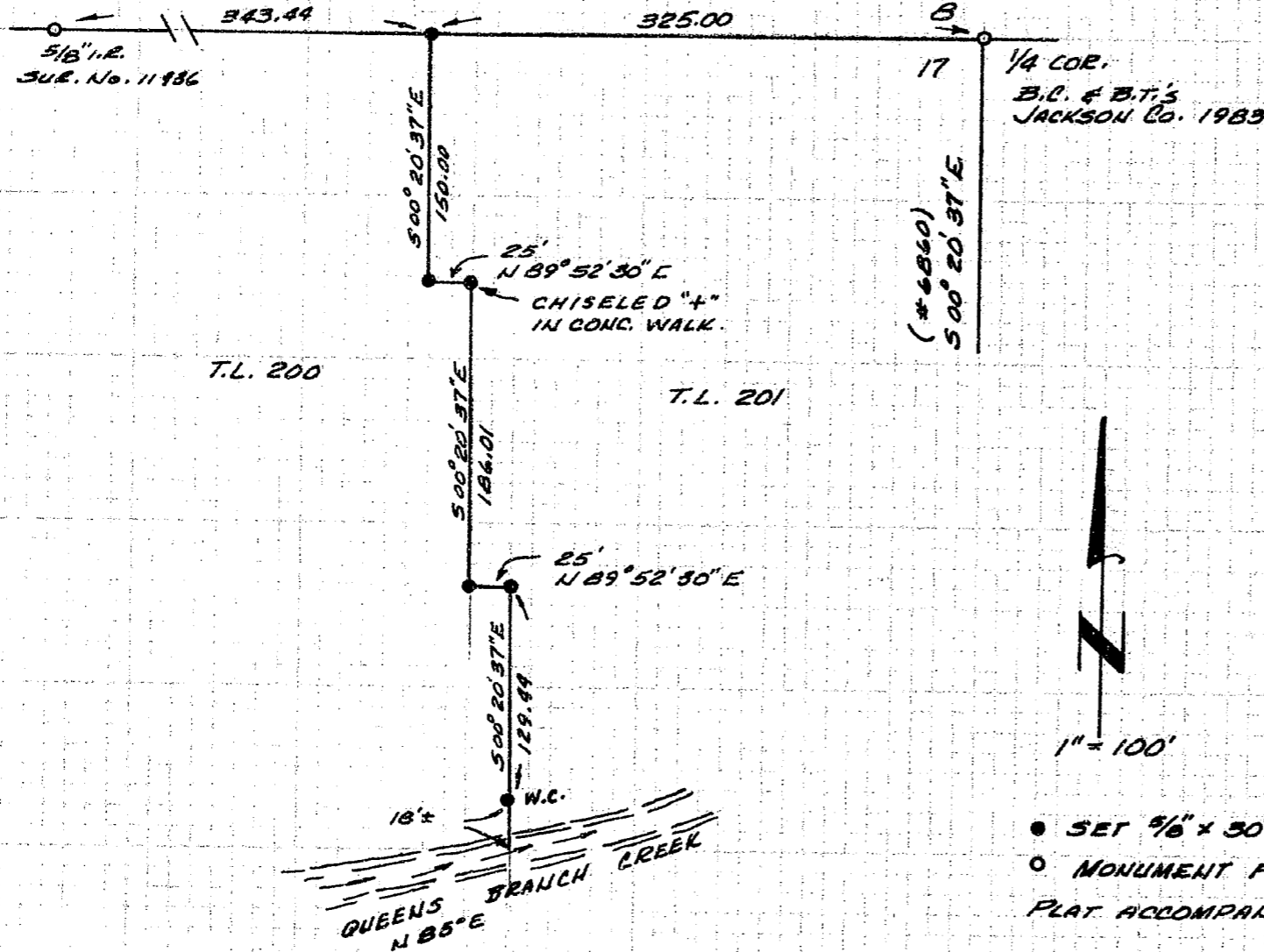

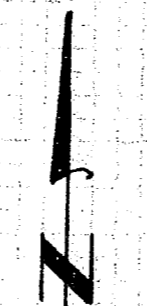

SURVEY NARRATIVE

Survey in the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 35 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose of Survey: To locate and monument the " Adjusted Line " common to Tax Lots 200 and 201 per Inst. No. 88-03236.

Procedure: Bearings are based on North line of Sec. 17 per Surveys No. 6860 and No. 11936.

I first determine the North line of Sec. 17, using monuments shown on plat. I then monument the common line between T.L.'s 200 and 201 according to Inst. No. 88-03236. The intent was to create approximately equal areas on each side of the original line so that the area of each tax lot would not change.
