set pins as shown on the attached plat.

The one-quarter corner common to sections 10 and 11 was re-established by the Jackson County Surveyors Office in 1915 by A.T. Brown who set an iron pin. The 2nd re-estab in 1937 by C.Z. Boyden set a 1" iron pipe directly over the iron pin set in 1915. The 3rd re-estab in 1974 by E. McGinty stated that an unrecorded 1 1/4" iron pipe was found to be westerly 1.12 feet from the 3rd re-estab position. The position of the 1 1/4" iron pipe fits more closely with the distance to the original B. Oak BT found by all County re-establishments. Also numerous surveys have held the position of the iron pipe as the true one-quarter corner prior to the 3rd reestablishment as well as after it. Based on the above, I also held the position of the iron pipe as the true one-quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 11.
