It would seem that a possible series of errors occurred between the person or persons that set out the construction stakes and the Contractor for not having checked for location before starting excavation. supervising Engineer or Designer, should have provided for the protection of the property line monumentation, as was filed for record only weeks before, as required by Oregon State Statute. Suffice it to say that not enough concern is shown to survey monumentation.
