

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

South one-half of the Northeast one-quarter (\$1/2 NE1/4) Section 20, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this survey is to document the parcel of land to be sold by the United States to Herman P. Oliver under authority of the Small Tracts Act. This sale of land and lot line adjustment resolves an encroachment of a pumphouse and driveway utilized by Herman P. Oliver. Authority for this sale is documented in the Small Tracts Act, PL 97-465 (16 U.S.C. 521d). This survey complies with the Small Tracts guidelines for the United States Forest Service, Case No. 1004.

An application for a Lot Line Adjustment of these parcels was submitted to the Jackson County Planning Department and was approved. Reference Jackson County File No. 90-17-LLA.

HISTORY OF PLSS SURVEYS: Section 20 was originally surveyed by Natanial Ford under Contract No.58 dated May 18, 1855, and dependantly resurveyed by the Bureau of Land Management in 1973. During this resurvey, the B.L.M. reestablished the West one-quarter (W1/4) corner and South one-quarter (S1/4) corner by proportionate measurement. In 1980 Thomas H. Cody Jr. LS 539, subdivided the the Northeast 1/4 of Section 20. Reference Record Survey No. 8623 filed with the Jackson County Surveyor. In 1981, evidence of the original corner point for the South one-quarter (S1/4) corner for Section 20 was recovered by the Jackson County Surveyor. The original corner point was remonumented and the Bureau of Land Management's proportioned monument was subsequently removed. Reference Jackson County Surveyor Project File No.81-11. Thomas H. Cody, Jr. did not perform a corrective resurvey.

SURVEY NO. 12167

In 1987, Larry Friar LS 961, subdivided Section 20, marking and posting the W1/2 NE1/4 for the United States Forest Service. Reference Record Survey No.11027 filed with the Jackson County Surveyor.

During Friar's survey it was discovered that several encroachments of improvements were situated on Government Land . Friar's report to the U.S. Forest Service dated 10/15/87 indicated that the well and driveway utilized by Herman P. Oliver were encroaching on Government Land. For ownership, reference Document #86- $0\overline{5}$ 968 Deed of Records, Jackson County, Oregon.

Friar also located the existing centerline of State Highway 227 that crosses National Forest System Lands within Section 20. This data is currently being used to establish the right-of-way easement limits to be granted to the Oregon Department of Transportation, through the Federal Highway Administration. There has been no official survey to monument the right-of-way limits, but by agreement between the Forest Service and the Oregon Department of Transportation the limits have been established. These limits are 66 feet either side of the existing centerline except for the parcel West of the current Tax Lots 200 & 300, (north of the Oliver property) where the right-of-way limit East of Highway 227 will be reduced to 30 feet. Reference Record Survey No.11922.

Harold L. Center PLS 1071 surveyed the parcels in the North one-half of the Northeast one-quarter (N1/2 NE1/4) Section 20 to resolve other encroachments found by Larry Friar. Reference Jackson County File 89-86-LLA and Record of Survey No. 11922 filed with the Jackson County Surveyor.

No other surveys are of record.

PROCEDURE:


I began this survey by tying into the controlling West line of the Southeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SE1/4 NE1/4) Section 20. This line is controlled by the Bureau of Land Management monument set at the East one-sixteenth (El/16) corner point for Sections 17 & 20, and the monument set by Larry Friar for the Center-east one-sixteenth (CE1/16) corner point for Section 20.

Utilizing the control survey for the Northeast one-quarter (NE1/4) of Section 20 established by Friar during Record Survey No. 11027, I conducted a site survey to determine the extent of the encroachment of Oliver's pumphouse and driveway on Government land. The locations of the well/pumphouse and driveway are diagramed on the attached map of survey.

The right-of-way limits for Highway 227 were determined by utilizing Friar's control survey for the existing centerline of the pavement. No monuments were set except as noted in surveys No. 11027 and 11922.

EQUIPMENT:

Equipment utilized throughout this survey include a Nikon NTD-4 electronic theodolite and distance meter.

CORNERS ACCEPTED FOR CONTROL

The control survey established during Record Surveys No. 11027 and 11922 were used as control for this survey. The corners accepted for control are as follows:

The East one-sixteenth (E1/16) corner for Sections 17 and 20, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

At the corner point, I found a standard Bureau of Land Management monument as described by Larry Friar, LS961; Reference Record Survey No. 11027.

The corner for Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

At the corner point, I found a standard Bureau of Land Management monument as described by Larry Friar, LS961; Reference Record Survey No. 11027.

The Center-east one-sixteenth (CE1/16) corner for Section 20, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

At the corner point, I found a 3-inch diameter brass disk as described by Larry Friar, LS961; Reference Record Survey No. 11027.

The one-quarter corner for Sections 20 and 21, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

At the corner point, I found a standard Bureau of Land Management monument as described by Larry Friar, LS 961; Reference Record Survey No. 11027.

I DID NOT ESTABLISH ANY NEW MONUMENTS THIS SURVEY.
