SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH CHAPTER 209, PARAGRAPH 250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

LOCATION:

In the SW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W.M., City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

Minor Land Partition: To locate and monument the boundaries of that tract described in Document Number 86-14655, Official Records, and to partition said tract into 2 parcels as shown on the attached plat and to dedicate street right of way, a bridge easement and Public Utility Easements as shown on the attached plats.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing center line monuments and proportionment data per R.S.N. 5802 as shown, computed the South line of the parent tract. Ties were made to the center line of the main track of the Southern Pacific Railroad and computations made to determine the railroad right of way. After a thorough search of title records it was determined that the City of Ashland holds title to only a 25 foot wide strip adjacent to the railroad as per Vol. 81, Pages 475 and 476, Deed Records. Therefore, my client is dedicating the 15 foot wide strip for street purposes as shown. Monuments set on this survey consist of 5/8" x 24" steel pins with red plastic caps mkd. D.A. EDWARDS-RPLS 2339".
