TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST SE 1/4 SECTION 10, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN,

JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this survey is to retrace and remonument certain property corners that define the boundaries of the United States Forest Service Ranger Station in the City of Butte Falls, Oregon. Reference Volume 197, page 470, and Document 70-07899, Deed of Records for Jackson County,

Oregon.

HISTORY OF SURVEYS:

Duane A.Smeltzer surveyed this parcel in 1970 for Medford

Corporation and the United States Forest Service.

Reference Record Survey No. 4283 filed with the Jackson County Surveyor. Arthur R. Rambo retraced a portion of this survey in 1979. Reference Record Survey No. 7606

filed with the Jackson County Surveyor. This survey borders Blocks 3-5 shown on the Original Town Plat and Block 26 shown on the East Bluff Addition for the

City of Butte Falls, filed with the Jackson County

Surveyor.

No other surveys are of record.

PROCEDURE:

I began my survey with an investigation of the property corners established by Duane A. Smeltzer. The first step was to contact Medco Surveyor Arthur R. Rambo because of his extensive survey control in and around the City of Butte Falls. Rambo showed me the property pins that he had located during previous surveys for Medford Corporation. I than began my own retracement to verify the location of property pins as diagramed on the attached map of survey. Utilizing Rambo's platted bearing from Record Survey No. 7606 (Southwest boundary of Butte Falls Ranger Station), I surveyed around the property and tied in all existing monuments. The monument at the Northwest corner of the property could not be found.

At locations where indicated on the attached map of survey I remonument directly over the existing monuments.

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The Local property owner in Block 26 (East Bluff Addition) adjacent to Forest Service property was consulted and made aware of the remonumentation.
