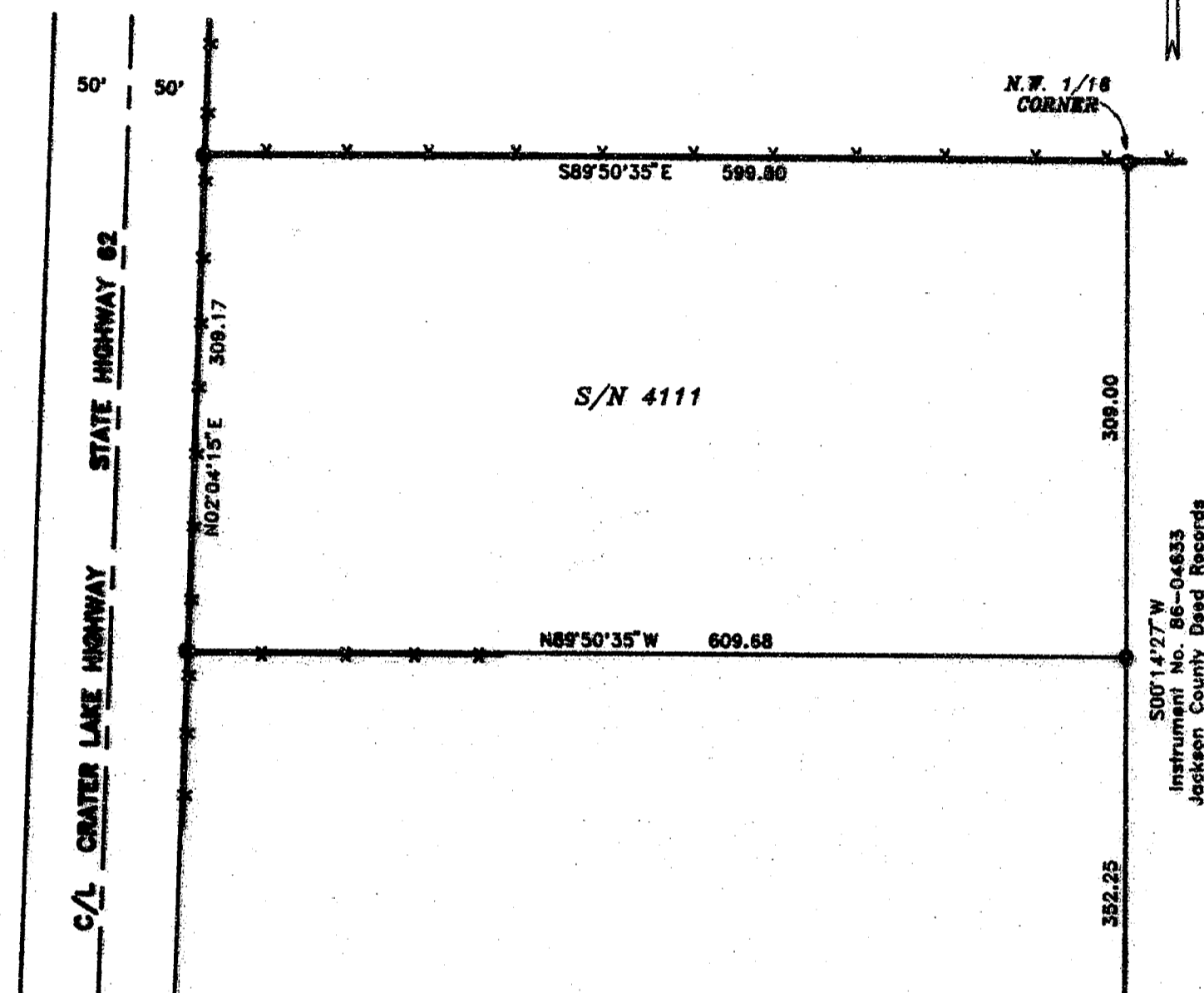


MAP OF SURVEY FOR DALE SPORES

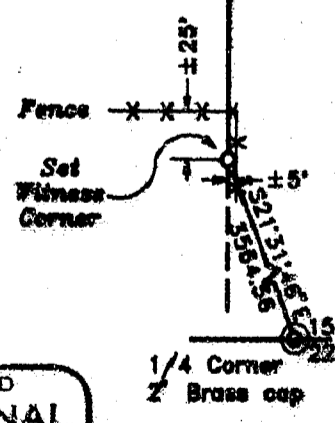

SURVEY FOR: Dale Spores

LOCATION: Situated in the Northwest one-quarter (1/4)
of Section 15, Township 35 South, Range 1
West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County,
Oregon.

PURPOSE: To mark and monument a portion of the West
line of that tract of land described in
Instrument No. 86-04633 of Jackson County
Deed Records.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a 1 second theodolite and
electronic distance measuring equipment a
control traverse was run tying found
monuments as set for survey No. 4111 and
also the South one-quarter (1/4) corner of
Section 15 which was part of the control for
Survey No. 4111.

An analysis was then made of the found
monuments and the position for the witness
monument was then computed and set as shown
on the attached map.
