I then traverse to the Center South 1/16 corner, at said point set:

A 5/8"x 30" Iron Rod, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Yellow Pine, 10" diameter bears S 13 ° E, 8.7 feet, scribed "CS1/16S22" "BT".
A Douglas Fir, 6" diameter bears S 73 ° E, 30.2 feet, scribed "CS1/16S22" "BT".

A found 5/8" iron rod set on RS 4398 bears S 08017'14" W, 1.10 feet.

I thence traverse S 89°57'51" E , 2664.26 feet to the South 1/16 on the East line of Section 22, at said point set:

A 5/8"x 30" Iron Rod, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Balck Oak, 11" diameter bears N 85 ° W, 28.9 feet, scribed "S1/16S22" "BT".
A Black Oak, 7" diameter bears N 57 ° W, 23.9 feet, scribed "S1/16S22" "BT".

I then set remaining corners as shown on accompanying plat.

PURPOSE:

To monument that tract of land described in Document Number 78-26919 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon as shown on

accompanying plat.

DATE:

December 4, 1990

BASIS OF

BEARING:

Based upon Recorded Survey number RS 4398, as shown on accompanying plat.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Nikon A-10, tied the Center and South Quarter corners, Northeast and Southeast Section corners. The East 1/4 corner was diligently searched for by myself and the Jackson County Surveyor's office with no results. From the control traverse, I set midway and on line between the Northeast and Southeast Section corners the proportionate East 1/4 corner, at said point set:

A 1"x 36" Iron Pipe, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Madrone, 13" diameter bears N 28 ° E, 17.1 feet, scribed "1/4S23" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 12" diameter bears S 78 ° E, 14.4 feet, scribed "1/4S23" "BT".

A Black Oak, 6" diameter bears S 40° W, 17.2 feet, scribed "1/4S22" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 6" diameter bears N 34 ° W, 4.2 feet, scribed "1/4S22" "BT".
