PURPOSE:

To monument the new boundaries created by a Lot-Line-Adjustment of Tax Lot Nos. 2500, 2600 and 2700, 36 1W-3AD being those tracts described in Instrument No. 90-27238 O.R. and Vol. 456, Page 378 D.R. prior to the adjustment. Also to prepare descriptions of the adjusted

lots.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. equipment traversed

around Blocks 7 and 8 tieing monuments indicated as found.

The 3/4" iron pin located at the centerline intersection of main street and Shasta Avenue and the 1" iron pipe with brass cap witness corner to the SE corner of D.L.C. No. 45 (both monuments set on the 1963 re-establishment of said SE corner of D.L.C. No. 45) were used for Main Street centerline control. The Neva Street centerline, Onyx Street centerline and lot boundaries in Block 7 were established at right angles and at record distance off the centerline of Shasta Avenue as shown on the annexed map, Shasta Avenue being controlled by Astbury and Tee monuments per Filed Survey No. 2327 located at the centerline intersection of said Shasta Avenue with the Lava Street and Onyx Street centerlines. Lengths of lines running parallel with Shasta Avenue we determined using the proportion of plat record distance and

measured distance between said Astbury and Tee monuments.

Tracts described in Vol. 460, Page 441 D.R. (Dated August 11, 1952), being the senior conveyance, was given the Deed Record 39.00 feet of Lot 11 and tract described in Vol. 433, Page 359 D.R. (Dated October 17, 1956) was given 27.014 feet, the remainder of Lot 11.

The new boundaries created by the Lot-Line- Adjustment was located per City of Eagle Point approval.
