PURPOSE:

gan angesan kaar til gyddistar til The purpose of this survey is to establish the Center one-quarter for Section 4, and to mark and post the property boundary between Bureau of Land Management property and private land within Section 4. This was a coorperative survey between the U.S. Forest Service and the Bureau of Land Management performed for a joint timber sale and also for the

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aquisition of right-of-way.

HISTORY OF SURVEYS:

The North Boundary and Subdivision of Township 41 South was first surveyed in 1882 by Samuel W. Lackland. In 1964 the Bureau of Land Management remonumented the section corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 41 South, Range 3 West and Sections 33 and 34, Township 40 South, Range 3 West. In 1967 the Bureau of Land Management remonumented the section corner common to Sections 4 and 5, Township 41 South, Range 3 West and Sections 32 and 33, Township 40 South, Range 3 West (visited by the Bureau of Land Management in 1982), and the one-quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 9 (visited by the Bureau of Land Management in 1974). In 1974 the Bureau of Land Management remonumented the one-quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 5.

In 1960 and again in 1981, the Jackson County Surveyor reestablished the one-quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4.

In 1977 the North Boundary of Section 4 was resurveyed by Harold Center, L.S. 1071. During this survey the one-quarter corner common to Section 4, Township 41 South, Range 3 West and Section 33, Township 40 South, Range 3 West was set by proportionate measurement. Reference Record Survey Number 6764, which was amended in 1982 by Record Survey Number 9267, filed with the Jackson County Surveyor.

No other surveys are of record.

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PROCEDURE:

In 1977 I resurveyed the North Boundary and set the North one-quarter corner of Section 4 by proportionate measurement (reference Record Survey Number 6764.) This survey was amended in 1982 by Record Survey Number 9267. During record Survey Number 9267 I ran a closed traverse between the East one-quarter corner, the West one-quarter corner, the Northwest section corner and the Northeast section corner of Section 4 for the marking and posting of property boundaries between previously set monuments.

Utilizing control established during Record Survey Number 9267, I began the current survey at the North one-quarter corner of Section 4 and ran a closed traverse southerly to the South one-quarter corner of Section 4 and established the Center one-quarter corner of Section 4.

Offsets were made from a random line to the true line and the north half of the North-South Centerline of Section 4 was then marked and posted with 6 foot aluminum posts with attached Bureau of Land Management property boundary signs. Trees were blazed to Bureau of Land Management standards and

the blazes sprayed with orange timber marking paint.

BASIS OF BEARING:

Solar Observation from Record Survey Number 6764.

Equipment used throughout this survey include a Wild T-2 Theodolite and a Sokkisha Red 2-L distance meter.

CORNERS ACCEPTED FOR CONTROL

One-quarter corner common to Section 33, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, and Section 4, Township 41 South, Range 3 West.

At the corner point I found a 2-1/2-inch diameter iron post with a 2-1/2-inch diameter brass cap set by Harold Center, L.S. 1071 in 1977, reference Record Survey Number 6764, which was amended in 1982 by Record Survey Number 9267, and marked:

A 20-inch diameter fir bears S.11°51'E., 48.30 feet distance (Record S.11°44'E., 49.19 ft.), scribe visible.

One-quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 41 South, Range 3 West.

This corner was visited in 1982 during Record Survey Number 9267, and the following data was gathered. At the corner point I found a 1-inch iron post with a 2-1/2-inch brass cap monument set by the Jackson County Surveyor in 1981, and marked:

A 14-inch diameter oak bears S.39° 36'E., 16.10 feet distance (Record S.40°00'E., 15.18 ft.), no marks visible on decayed face.

A 7-inch diameter fir bears $\rm N.23^{\circ}~25^{\circ}W.$, 25.30 feet distance (Record $\rm N.23^{\circ}30^{\circ}W.$, 24.50 ft.), with a healed blaze.

One-quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 41 South, Range 3 West.

At the corner point I found a standard Bureau of Land Management brass cap monument marked:

A 36-inch diameter pine bears N.30° 39'E., 18.20 feet distance (Record N.31°00'E., 17.82 ft.), scribe 1/4 S visible on a partially healed blaze.

A 10-inch diameter fir bears 5.32° 20'W., 2.70 feet distance (Record 5.39° 00'W, 2.64 ft.), with a healed blaze.

A 27-inch diameter pine bears S.51° 52'W., 50.41 feet distance (Record S.53°00'W., 48.84 ft.), with a healed blaze.

One-quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 5, Township 41 South, Range 3 West.

A 10-inch diameter pine bears 5.40° 42'W., 5.00 feet distance (Record 5.45° 00'W., 4.95 ft.), scribed 1/4 S5 BT on a partially healed blaze.
