Purpose:

To survey and monument the boundary of that tract of land described as "Tract B" in Instrument No. 86-08637 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon

theodolite and second 1 Utilizing a electronic distance measuring equipment a control traverse was run tying found monuments as shown on the attached map. No monumentation was found in Block 17 so the centerline monuments found on Central Street, Helman Street and North Main were held Procedure: for control.

There are no monuments of record for the relocated Highway 99 which bounds the southerly line of the subject tract. State Highway design information was obtained from City of Ashland Engineering Department. A centerline design station was given for the monument at the intersection of Bush Street and North Main Street. From this station the centerline of relocated Highway 99 was computed using design station distances and design Highway 99 was computed using design station distances and design curve information.
