Location:

SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 32 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

C-W-NE-SE monument the C-W-E-E 1/256, To 1/256, NE-SE 1/16 corners of Section 30, also monument the Northerly line of exception "a" Parcel 3, Vol. 531, Pg. 204 of the Official Deed Records of Jackson County.

Date:

April 22, 1991

Basis of Bearing:

Based upon the South line of Section 30 per Recorded Survey number 8364.

Procedure:

Utilizing a Nikon Topgun A-10 total station tied Center, East, South Quarter Corners, SE corner of Section 30 and the CE 1/16 corner as monumented by RS 8364. The calculated outside boundary of the SE 1/4 checked very close with Recorded Survey number 8364. However the CE 1/16 corner was found N 71°53'54" W, 1.91 feet from my calculated position. I held my calculated position and ran N 89018'58" East, 324.46 feet to the C-W-E-E 1/256 corner from which I set:

A 5/8"x 30" Rebar, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Douglas Fir, 10" diameter bears N 28° E, 9.2 feet, scribed "C-W-E-E 1/256" "BT". A Douglas Fir, 12" diameter bears N 28° W, 6.0 feet, scribed "C-W-E-E-1/256" "BT".

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I then run S 00001'03" E, 662.65 feet to the C-W-NE-SE 1/256 corner from which I set:

A 5/8"x 30" Rebar, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Douglas Fir, 18" diameter bears N 26° E, 5.9 feet, scribed "C-W-NE-SE 1/256" "BT". A Hemlock, 4" diameter bears S 40° E, 11.0 feet, scribed "C-W-NE-SE-1/256" "BT".

I then run N 89°18'31" E, 326.05 feet to the NE-SE 1/64 corner from which I set:

A 5/8"x 30" Rebar, with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which I scribe the following bearing trees:

A Sugar Pine, 6" diameter bears N 60° E, 19.3 feet, scribed "NE-SE 1/64" "BT".
A Douglas Fir, 10" diameter bears N 28° W, 6.8 feet, scribed "NE-SE 1/64" "BT".

I then run S 00009'16" E, 662.59 feet to a point which is 300.00 feet Northwesterly of a survey line described in exception "a" of Parcel 3, Vol. 531, Pg. 204 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. I then run line parallel and 300.00 feet northwesterly of said described line as shown on accompanying plat to the South line of Section 30.

The U.S.F.S. was notified of their position of the CE 1/16, as I find it. They are in the process of field checking their work, as of this date.
