Utilizing ties to center line monuments, monuments of record per recorded surveys numbered 8463, 10436 and 11988, as well as data of record per these surveys and R.S.N. 5874, computed the existing boundaries of Block 19 as shown on the accompanying plat. The relationship between the 1888 "City of Ashland" plat and current measurements was found to be amazingly close. The original lot corners were computed by proportion method. While the documents noted above contain the descriptions for the subject parcels, other, much older deeds were also researched and used to control the boundaries in question. Volume 180, Pg. 52 and Vol. 177, Pg. 537 were among the latter. As shown on the attached plat, the Northerly line of Doc. No. 77-08523 falls in a retaining wall. These monuments in fact are 0.04' S'ly from the N'ly edge of said wall. Also with regard to this parcel, the current owners acquired title through Doc. No. 85-02574, wherein a portion of the description found in Doc. No. 77-08523 and previous deeds was omitted by the scrivener. It was obviuos what had happened and I therefore monument the boundary at the previously described location. Efforts by title company personnel are under way to correct the oversight. Monuments set on this survey consist of $5/8" \times 24"$ steel pins with red plastic caps mkd. "D.A. EDWARDS-RPLS 2339" unless otherwise noted on attached plat.
