Corner, Section 17 and 18, Found 4° x 6° Oak Stake scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$ °S. on North and South face, approximately 20 to 30 years old also found a 20° Fir N.57°E., 12.5 ft. Scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$ , approximately 60 to 70 years ago, neither of the two original trees where found, this being the accepted corner for many years. I removed stake and set a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ° x  $\frac{1}{2}$ ° Iron bar 30° long and 24° in ground. From which the above 16° Fir bear N.57°E., 12.5 ft. Scribed a 9° laurel 301 B T, bears S.76°W., 23.35 ft.
