PURPOSE: To monument tracts described in
Instrument Nos. 89-16783 O.R. and
89-12744 O.R.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing E.D.M. equipment traversed
around the subject tracts tying monuments indicated as
found, the center of the Red Blanket Road pavement (which in
some areas does not stay within the 40' wide petition right-
of-way) and left control points near monuments set. C. Z.
Boyden made an extensive survey in this area for the Rogue
River Timber Co. in 1929, see County Survey Intermediate
Corner Book for 1/16 corners and 1/64 corners monumented on
this survey.

The East-Half of the NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of
Section 27 was partitioned leaving a gap 1.7' ± wide East of
the East boundary of tract described in Vol. 248, Page 512.
