PURPOSE:

To monument the new boundary between tracts described in Inst. Nos. and 89-13483 O.R. as 90-01364 approved for Lot Line Adjustment by the City of Shady Cove Planning Commission on July 24, 1991. Also to prepare descriptions adjusted tracts and the proposed

Ingress-Egress easement.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. equipment,

found monuments shown on the accompanying map. Two monuments from Filed Survey Nos. 9214 and 11866 were found (not including the S.W. corner of Section 15) and a tie between the two checked mathematically with our present work so no bearing difference between those surveys and this is needed. Also picked-up a pin finder indication for two other monuments from these surveys (see map) under the A.C. parking lot pavement which generally checked the record positions. From this data the required boundaries from these surveys and Inst. No. 90-01314 were computed.

Found monuments on the Westerly boundary of the cemetery tract, Vol. 173, Page 457 D.R., as shown. The origin of these monuments are unknown, they do fit the physical location of the cemetery. The 1 %" iron pin found set for
