

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES



PROCEDURE:

In reviewing the narrative of Survey No. 773, which monumented the boundaries of the property adjoining the subject property on the north side, a reference to a Circuit Court Decree was noted. This decree evidently outlined a ruling concerning the location of a larger parcel of property. I found the document in the Circuit Court Journal on pages 463 through 466, dated October 15, 1908, under the name of Wm. J. Warner. This document is also on microfilm, Volume 14, Page 463 in the Circuit Court Archives.

According to the Decree, the parcel involved was originally described as "Beginning 6 chains and 50 links east of the Northwest corner of the Orchard Home Association Tract . . . , thence south 16 chains and 6 links; thence east 6 chains and 6 links; thence north 16 chains and 6 links; thence west 6 chains and 6 links to the place of beginning". The Decree then changed the description to the following: "Beginning 6.50 chains east of the northeast corner of DLC No. 79; thence east 6.06 chains; thence south 16.32 chains; thence west 6.06 chains; thence north 16.32 chains to the place of beginning". There is also a statement in the the material difference in said Decree that descriptions being that there is a difference of about 26 links in the length of the tract last above described.

The parcel which I have been asked to survey is a part of the above described tract, as was that parcel monumented by Survey No. 773. Therefore the same control was used on this survey as was used on Survey No. 773 to locate and monument the parcel boundaries. As shown on the map, the south boundary as monumented is approximately 18 feet north of the north boundary of Lot 21 of Orchard Home Association, and approximately 17 feet north of an old fenceline. This corresponds with the distance of "about 26 links", mentioned above in the Circuit Court Decree, which converts to approximately 17 feet.
