Procedure: The division of this parcel is based upon a survey [No. 2807] performed in 1965, The purpose of said survey being to define and document lines acceptable to Anderson, who at the time was owner of subject parcel, and Buck to the East and Breeding The description of said parcel is in agreement with to the West. the boundaries established by the survey.

I was able to recover all those monuments defining the property and found there position to be consistant with those shown on said survey plat. I did find minor variations but did not note same except in the area to be segregated.

Bearings are based on the two monuments on the Southerly line of Foothill Blvd.
