A thorough research of public records indicated there had been several prior surveys that created the basic outer boundary of this partition. Initially, a U.S. Forest Service cadastral contract (No. 53-04HI-0-7993-N) established the property lines and corners that are a part of the Public Land Survey System in Survey Number 8683, filed with the Jackson County Surveyor. Subsequent surveys involved amending some of these property lines and corners with Lot Line Adjustments; as recorded in Documents No. 90-05497, 90-05498, 90-05499 & 90-12405 of the Official Records of Jackson County and Surveys Numbered 12060 & 10392, filed with the Jackson County Surveyor.

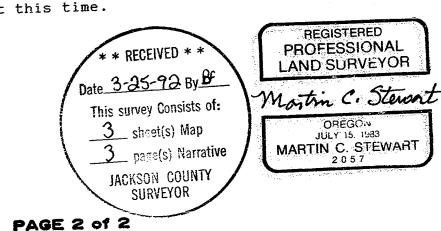
There is one 20 foot wide Right of Way granted to Pacific Power and Light in Volume 544 Page 234 of the Deed Records of Jackson County and a earlier 20 foot wide Right of Way granted to the California Oregon Power Company (Volume 336 Page 116 of the Deed Records of Jackson County); as there is only one set of transmission and communication lines and they are interspersed with Copco as well as PP&L wooden poles, both Right of Ways appear to cover the same set of

lines.

The variable width EXCLUSIVE slope easement granted to the U.S. Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, as created originally in No.75-14685 and amended in Correction Deeds No. 87-03451 & 87-05570 of said Official Records revealed a survey not on file with the Jackson County Surveyor. 5/8" iron rebars established in this easement survey are noted with respect to correctly established and filed surveys; these corners are set with respect to the beginning and ending of this easemnent as described in these documents. Record location places these corners on the East-West centerline of Section 5 and the Section Line common to Sections 4 and 5 respectively; and these corners were found well within acceptable limits. Accordingly, they appear to be holding the right and left easement lines with respect to these section lines. Portions of this easement were recomputed as errors were discovered based on usable information and exsisting improvements as per Document No. 75-14685 of said Official Records.

A 1" \times 30" galvanized iron pipe was set on this partition for the intersection point of the northerly line of this partition with the westerly line of Beaver Creek (County) Road and the U.S.Forest Service slope easement line. It bears witness to the controlling call of the "Westerly line of Beaver Creek Road" (County Road); "as said road existing (sic) Febuary 28,1956" (No. 90-05498 of said Official Records). This survey did not attempt to retrace this line as there is insufficient information of public record and previous physical locations may have been obscured by the subsequent improvements. Accordingly the existing improvements were utilized as they appear to best substaniate this location. Meetings with U.S.F.S Officials as well as with the director of Jackson County Public Works Department confirmed that our best evidence controlling the position of these easements i.e., Beaver Creek (County) Road and the U.S.F.S.slope easement, were the existing improvements which are noted with respect to these

easements.
Survey Number 4038 notes a 5/8" pipe on the section line common to Sections 4 and 5, however it is not tied with respect to other corners. A diligent search of the area revealed only a 2" iron pipe. It was found northwesterly of the INITIAL POINT and was found to be 8.2' south of the computed South 1/16th corner. As this differs markedly from the description of the monument mentioned in S.N. 4038 and there is no way to retrace the location of this 5/8" pipe with respect to this found 2" pipe, it is noted as found but it's origin is unknown at this time.
