I then returned to the C 1/4 corner and ran S 89°34'23" E, 1297.59 feet to the CE 1/16 corner, at said CE 1/16 corner set:

A 1"x 30" iron pipe with yellow plastic cap marked, "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which scribed the following bearing tree:

A Cedar, 8" diameter bears S 22°E, 7.4 feet, scribed "CE 1/16S36" "BT".

A Madrone, 13" diameter bears N 76°W, 13.0 feet, scribed " CE 1/16S36" "BT".

I then ran N 00°05'52" E, 2637.21 feet to the E 1/16 corner between Section 25 and 36, at said E 1/16 corner set:

A 5/8"x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked, "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which scribed following bearing tree:

A Douglas Fir, 13" diameter bears S 190W, 12.0 feet, scribed " E1/16S36" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 6" diameter bears N 610W, 8.6 feet, scribed " E1/16S25" "BT".

PURPOSE:

To run and mark true line as shown on

accompanying plat.

BASIS OF BEARING:

Bearings based upon Solar Observation.

PROCEDURE

Tied the North, South, East and West Quarter corners, along with the NE corner of Section 36. Computed the C 1/4 corner position from control traverse and at said C 1/4 set:

A 1"x 30" iron pipe with yellow plastic cap marked, "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which scribed the following bearing tree:

A Black Oak, 8" diameter bears N 5°E, 10.6 feet,

A Black Oak, 8" diameter bears N 5°E, 10.6 feet, scribed "C1/4S36" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 6" diameter bears N 38°E, 21.0 feet, scribed "C1/4S36" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 12" diameter bears S 37°E, 20.4 feet, scribed "C1/4S36" "BT".

A Black Oak, 5" diameter bears S 12°W, 21.7 feet, scribed " C1/4S36" "BT".

I then ran true line S 00°20'28" E, 2678.00 feet to the S 1/4 of Section 36, which was blazed and painted red.
