

DECLARATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, James B. Smith and Anna Mae Smith are the owners in fee simple and that we, Jack Elam and Margaret J. We do hereby dedicate to the public for street purposes the area shown hereon as Barrington Place. PURPOSE:

BARRINGTON PLACE SUBDIVISION; P.A. 91-118. To monument the lot corners and right of way as shown on the accompanying plat and to prepare and record said plat in order to create said lots, open space area and certain public

utility easements as shown.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing existing control points and data established by this office during the execution of Recorded Survey Number 12453, set lot corners and right of way monuments at their computed locations as shown. Monuments set on this survey consist of 5/8" x 30" steel pins with red plastic caps mkd. "D.A. EDWARDS-LS 2339" or lead plug and tack set in concrete curb with brass washer mkd. "LS 2339".
