PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. Equipment,

initiated a traverse at control points established on DEER PARK ESTATES and traversed to and around the subject tract tieing monuments indicated as found.

The monument found set on Filed Survey No. 8638 for the C.N. 1/16 corner was found to be 0.14 North and 0.44 West of a mid point between the center % corner and the North % corner. Even though I accept the 1" iron pipe as the center % corner and Filed Survey No. 8638 did not, I still accept the C.N. 1/16 corner monument as found as it is positionally within limits per the BLM manuel.

The position established but not monumented for the Southeast corner of the subject tract on Filed Survey No. 10346 at record distance from the C.N. 1/16 corner was accepted as the tract described in Volume 314, Page 82 D.R. The Southwest corner of the is the senior conveyance. subject tract was proportioned utilizing distances shown in Volume 321, Page 5 and Volume 323, Page 211 D.R. as both conveyances were signed on June 20, 1949, consequently no junior-senior rights.
